

WORDPRESS WRITING A PLUGIN

A WordPress Plugin is a program or a set of one or more functions written in the PHP scripting language, that adds a specific set of features or services to the.

If you used a local environment to create your plugin, you just need to right-click on the folder and select Compress. This method is appropriate for data not associated with individual posts, pages, attachments, or comments -- the type of data that will grow as time goes on, and that doesn't have individual names. In fact, you can add the same code to either a plugin or functions. The best way to get started is by creating your own plugins. Filters : These are used to alter the functionality of actions. All you need to do is to compress the very-first-plugin folder into a ZIP file.
